## **Principals, Students and Parents:**

### Registration Open Now for Summer School July 4- August 1

- Registration closes July 4
- Grade 9 students may enroll in a 3 credit orientation course NOW to complete before the end of JUNE so they are ready to start core courses in grade 10
- August diplomas start August 1
- Earn credits while you work (applies to Rutherford Scholarship and 30 level credits for diploma)
- Limit of one core course
- Plan on committing 5 hours/day to complete a 5 credit course by June 27 (Humanities) August 1 (math and Science)
- Must complete or have completed 3 credit online orientation course
- Students will experience a delay in access to their online course if they do not have a Palliser <u>@prs26.ca</u> account
- Students must authenticate their Palliser mail to Moodle before they can access courses

## **Finishing Semester 2**

#### **Course Deadlines:**

- Diploma Courses: June 2, 2017
- Non-diploma Courses: June 9, 2017

Students must not assume they can continue into the summer semester unless the student re-registers for the summer semester. If students do not re-register for summer, and are not completed a course, marks will be reported incomplete to Alberta Education and will show on the student transcript.

Please be in touch with your teacher(s) directly before this date if you have questions or concerns.

We will be doing major upgrades to our server this summer. All courses must be completed by June 9 to ensure that student work can be assessed for credit before changes are made to the courses over the summer.

#### Writing Course Final Exams

- Be in touch with your teacher to book your exam writing. Organizing final exams requires a little coordination with your school to ensure we have a Palliser staff who will supervise and that the exam and password are made available to your school site.
- The Palliser Beyond Borders teacher will confirm that the student has met all the prerequisite skills in preparation for the summative assessment. This is also true for diploma exams.
- 3. Students must work with the teacher through the teaching, learning and assessment process which includes both formative and summative assessment. Students cannot hand in assignments the day before an exam or diploma exam and expect that permission will be granted to write a final exam or diploma exam. Teacher feedback and opportunity for improvement is part of the learning process before summative assessments take place.

You may be expected to use a lockdown browser which ensures the integrity of the exam and reassures universities that final exam marks are legitimate and our teaching and learning community exercises academic integrity. Universities also use lockdown browsers in their invigilation as well. If you need a reminder about using the lockdown browsers watch this video available on our website under Exam Policy

#### Diploma Exams: Start June 15

**Diploma Course Reviews:** The discrepancy between our diploma marks and course marks closed quite significantly last year. The common factor was that students made sure they had the time to participate in diploma course reviews either online or face to face. Part of our course expectations is for students to attend these course reviews. Review dates are posted on <u>our website</u>

**On Exam Day:** Arrive 30 minutes early to the site you at which you plan to attend to get settled and to log on to a computer if you are writing part A of Social Studies or English using a word processing tool.




