Important Deadline: The contest is open until 5:00PM on February 21st, 2016 and the Top 3 judged flags will be announced on March 18th, 2016, the birthday of Princess Louise Caroline Alberta, the beautiful Princess the beautiful province is named after.

Note: Between March 18th, 2016 and August 6th, Alberta youth will be voting on the top 3 Alberta Birthday Flag designs. The flag with the most votes shall be hoisted for the first time on September 1st, 2016 at the 2nd Annual Alberta Birthday Extravaganza, held at the Historic Bow Valley Ranche, located in Fish Creek Provincial Park in front of over 1,000 people!

Submitting Flag design:
