We want students to submit assignments regularly and follow our tips for successful online learning. Students can not submit a whole course the night before an exam or diploma exam and accept that it is ok to "take the bad mark". We feel bad if students don't do well on exams and want to support every effort for students to demonstrate their very best understanding in our courses.

Students who plan to finish their courses by the January reporting period are expected to write their final exam in January. If you have not identified a time with your teacher please register yourself in the location you wish to write:

- Sign up on this spreadsheet
- Look at the tab along the bottom and select your courses either non diploma or diploma. Exams are for sciences, maths and English
- If you are able to write at an Outreach select the appropriate column.
- If you are outside of Palliser you must arrange for a proctor. We will send a proctor form to you and your proctor. The proctor will be given the exam information.
- If you are in a Palliser School please indicate which one and we will arrange for invigilation of the exam.
- Please plan to arrive 15 minutes before the exam. You will be asked to log on to a chrome book wither via a lockdown browser or with a password.

#### **Diploma Courses and Protocols**

Diploma Course Reviews: The discrepancy between our diploma marks and course marks closed quite significantly last year. The common factor was that students made sure they had the time to participate in diploma course reviews either online or face to face. Part of our course expectations is for students to attend these course reviews.

### Crash Courses- HCS 3000 and Getting Online (GO) orientation


- HCS 3000 is a mandatory prerequisite for work experience and Registered Apprenticeships (RAP)
- Getting Online is a mandatory prerequisite for all students taking their first online course with Palliser Beyond Borders
- These courses will be offered in a crash course format and require 2 hours online with our teacher for the assessment. Students will be required to do some prior work online.
