## Section 5: Signatures of Student Applicant and Parents

All International Students, regardless of age, choosing to enroll in Palliser Regional Schools must participate according to the following conditions:

1. The student must obey the laws of Canada, the Province of Alberta, and follow the rules, guidelines and policies of Palliser Regional Schools and the school in which the student is enrolled.
2. The student may be required to sign a faith covenant before attending Palliser's faith-based alternative programs.
3. The student must follow all specific school and Board regulations regarding attendance, course responsibilities and behaviors. The student must attend school on a daily basis. A written note from a homestay parent or doctor should be submitted to the school when absent.
4. The student will make every effort to learn English and become an active member in their homestay family and in their school community, including extra-curricular activities.
5. The student shall show respect for their homestay family and obey all homestay rules. The student shall pay for all damages that he/she incurs while in the home.
6. The student shall not consume alcohol, use illegal drugs or be involved in sexual relations while enrolled in the Palliser International Student Program.
7. The Palliser International Student Program may make changes to the student's homestay arrangements.
8. The student shall not drive motorized vehicles except within the context of a formal driver's training program. The Palliser International Student Program will hold the student's driver's license until the student returns to their home country.
9. The student must maintain a full-time timetable. In a semester-based secondary school, this means 4 courses per semester and in a non semester-based school, this means 8 courses for the year.
10. The student must maintain a 70% average overall.
11. The student's reports on attendance, academics and emotional/psychological concerns can be shared with parents, custodian, agents, school and Board personnel in order to provide the necessary guidance and assistance for student success.
12. The student and family acknowledge that based on the information in the application, the Palliser International Student Program has the right to make educational decisions, including placement and program selections in the best interest of the student within the available resources.
13. The student must depart the country by June 30th or after the semester has ended for a student staying only one semester. Medical coverage must be in place for students during their entire stay and additional coverage must be purchased if the stay is extended for any reason.
14. The student and family understand and agree that inaccuracies in the application or failure to abide by the above conditions may result in immediate dismissal from the Palliser International Student Program without refund of program fees. If it is determined by the Palliser International Student Program that the student's
