



## CCWA Community Service Award for Palliser Beyond Borders Coaldale - \$500

Service is all about giving back to your community or giving to others and their communities. Service offers you the opportunity to engage with society and gain an understanding of the importance of your role within your immediate and global community. It gives you the chance to connect with individuals and groups you may have previously overlooked or not been aware of, and to make a real difference in your wider community.

Recipients of the Community Service Award demonstrate dedication to their community by providing service in the following areas:

- Assisting the elderly, sick, people with a disability or disadvantaged (in an organized setting or on an individual basis).
- Volunteering work for non-profit organizations.
- Participating in organizations that strive to empower youth to be responsible, caring and contributing leaders. (4H Club, Cadets, Boy Scouts, Girl Guides, etc.)
- Being a youth leader; volunteering on committees at school and other organizations.

**Using the above criteria, please summarize the following information in resumé format.**

- **Header:** Name, address, phone number, email, other.
- **Personal Summary:** highlight your top skills and achievements in one or two sentences.
- **Education:** list of all grade 12 courses completed and enrolled in up to April 1<sup>st</sup>, anticipated graduation date, and any other academic achievements.
- **Volunteer Activity:** list the organizations you have volunteered with over the past three years. List your role within the organization. Write a brief statement summarizing the goal of each organization and what you enjoyed or learned from each organization regardless of whether it was a positive or negative experience. Include the total number of volunteer hours for each organization.
- **Skills:** provide a list of general skills and skills gained by your volunteer experience.

Write a cover letter introducing yourself and highlight your volunteer experience, the goal of each organization and the experience gained by your participation. Including future aspirations as to how you plan to continue your volunteerism after high school would be an asset.

*Applicants must be a graduating grade 12 student attending PBB and residing in Coaldale, AB or surrounding area. Applications will be judged by the CCWA Awards Committee based on volunteer activity, leadership roles, and overall presentation of resumé and cover letter. The successful applicant will be required to submit their SIN for the purpose of issuing a T4A tax form as per CRA regulations.*
