Notes from your Palliser Beyond Borders Principal

Is your learning on track for successful completion?

Students who register with us for the first time are expected to complete our <u>Getting Online</u> course. This course teaches students how to

- learn online
- submit assignments
- use Google Apps for Education in the Moodle learning platform
- communicate with teachers
- and be successful online learners.

If you were registered in the first week of school you should have now completed the course and moved on to your academic course.

What do you do if you have not finished GO?

- Get online. Open up the course and continue! On average we know that students will successfully complete after 16 log ins and working through assignments an hour at a time. This could be 16 log ins over two weeks or 16 log ins over a year! We want you to finish GO this week.
- Fix if something is not right? We have a 10 minute rule of thumb at Palliser Beyond Borders. If something is amiss reach out for help. Don't sit and wait and say I'll figure it out tomorrow. Let's get it figured out today so you can move on.
- <u>Use Technology for learning.</u> We do not want technology to be the barrier to learning. We need to shift from "learning to use technology" to "using technology for learning" in the first two weeks of school. Ask for help.

Get help



- Refer to the Teacher information block in your Moodle course. This is an example.
- Email <u>keith.harrison@pallisersd.ab.ca</u> or <u>Jacob.fraser@pallisersd.ab.ca</u> in GO or your teacher in other courses.
- Use 20th century technology: Call your teacher.
- Book a meeting by phone, google hang out, face to face, Blackboard
- Drop into our Blackboard sessions to meet with a teacher on duty
 - See the schedule on your newsfeed dashboard in Moodle
 - See the <u>schedule on our website</u> under current students
- Come to Tuesday night study hall 4:30 pm –
 6:30 pm. Bruno and Keith can help get you on track.
- Ask your Outreach teacher to help even if your subject teacher is someone else. All of our teachers know how to get help for you.
- Stay in regular contact with your teacher

Research tells us the most successful online students are those who know their teacher and know how to reach out for help. Your job now is to build a strong learning and teaching relationship with your teacher.

Completing Courses and Exam Protocols - students please read

We want students to submit assignments regularly and follow our tips for successful online learning. Students can not submit a whole course the night before an exam or diploma exam and accept that it is ok to "take the bad mark". We feel bad if students don't do well on exams and want to support every effort for students to demonstrate their very best understanding in our courses.

Students: be aware that each course has different exam protocols depending on the subject. Be in touch with your teacher to book your exam writing. Organizing final exams requires a little coordination with your school to ensure we have a Palliser staff who will supervise and that the exam and password are

made available to your school site. Please give your teacher one day notice to make the arrangements. This includes the Outreaches. If Palliser staff is not available we will need to make Procter arrangements, which require forms and signatures.

Please note that courses need to be completed within one calendar year of the student's start date. These deadlines mean that all assignments and exams must be submitted on or before the date.

Use these course completion dates to plan your academic plan for 2016-17 year:

October 24, 2016	Diploma courses for those writing diploma exams in November. Deadline to hand in assignments and begin review
October 26, 2016	Non-diploma courses for November reporting period
November 4, 2016.	Report cards will be mailed out
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December 21, 2016	Diploma courses for those writing diploma exams in January. Deadline to hand in assignments and begin review
January 13, 2017	Non-diploma courses for January reporting period
January 27, 2017	Report cards will be mailed out
March 22, 2017	Diploma courses for those writing diploma exams in April deadline to hand in assignments and begin review
March 24, 2017	Non-diploma courses for April reporting period
April 7, 2017	Report cards will be emailed out
June 2, 2017	Diploma courses for those writing diploma exams in January deadline to hand in assignments and begin review
June 9, 2017	Non-diploma courses for January reporting period
June 23, 2017	Report cards will be mailed out

Diploma Courses and Protocols

Diploma Course Reviews: The discrepancy between our diploma marks and course marks closed quite significantly last year. The common factor was that students made sure they had the time to participate in diploma course reviews either online or face to face. Part of our course expectations is for students to attend these course reviews. Review dates are posted on our website

Finishing your course on time by meeting posted deadlines: If students do not meet the deadline dates for completing courses, students must plan to write the diploma in the next cycle. We want you to have the review time you need after teacher assessment is complete to ensure you are ready for the summative assessment.

- September 1: all completed registrations will have courses available at moodle.prs26.ca for school start up on September 6
- September 10: all summer work experience course hours and required documents must be submitted for credit submission to Alberta Education on September 15.


