Are you *doing* your courses or *understanding* & *showing* your learning?

Students: As of November 15 there are **35 more days** for students to submit their assignments in Diploma courses if students plan to write in the January exam period. All assignments must be submitted for assessment by **December 21, 2016 for January diploma writing.** Why?

- Diplomas start January 13 and we return from winter break on January 9.
- This gives teachers the time to assess your work for understanding and give back to you to bump up your understanding.
- This gives you the winter break to review your learning and prepare for your diploma
- This gives you the opportunity to join the review sessions planned in January after the winter break so that your focus is on successful review rather than new learning. It is time for you to synthesize your

understanding so you are prepared for the diploma exam.

Diploma review session information is posted in your diploma course and also on our website under the <u>Current Students tab.</u>

For All Students: At Palliser Beyond Borders we are proud of our students who focus on sharing their understanding of learning concepts with their teachers. When students are engaged in showing their learning, rather than simply saying "I did that assignment," students understand that formative assessment gives them the opportunity to bump up their level of performance and ultimately, their marks.

As you work to complete your courses replace the inner voice that says "*I have to get this done*" with:

"How can I show my understanding and learning?"

Completing Courses and Exam Protocols - students please read

We want students to submit assignments regularly and follow our tips for successful online learning. Students can not submit a whole course the night before an exam or diploma exam and accept that it is ok to "take the bad mark". We feel bad if students don't do well on exams and want to support every effort for students to demonstrate their very best understanding in our courses.

Students: be aware that each course has different exam protocols depending on the subject. Be in touch with your teacher to book your exam writing. Organizing final exams requires a little coordination with your school to ensure we have a Palliser staff who will supervise and that the exam and password are made available to your school site. Please give your teacher one day notice to make the arrangements. This includes the Outreaches. If Palliser staff is not available we will need to make Procter arrangements, which require forms and signatures.

Please note that courses need to be completed within one calendar year of the student's start date. These deadlines mean that all assignments and exams must be submitted on or before the date.

Diploma Courses and Protocols

Diploma Course Reviews: The discrepancy between our diploma marks and course marks closed quite significantly last year. The common factor was that students made sure they had the time to participate in diploma course reviews either online or face to face. Part of our course expectations is for students to attend these course reviews. Review dates are posted on <u>our website</u>


